Thank you for your interest in the Burlington Children's Space. The Burlington Children's Space offers care for children between the ages of 6 weeks to those leaving for kindergarten. We are currently open M-F 8:00am-4:00pm. A limited number of part-time slots are available within the program.

New children usually enter the program in September, but the enrollment process begins in January, with siblings and staff babies given priority. After current families have been enrolled, we will contact wait list members about any openings we have.

Burlington Children's Space Rates

Included here are the rates for the 2026-2027 school year. Burlington Children's Space has monthly fixed tuition rates. These rates include breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack. Enrolled families agree to pay the full cost or apply for Child Care Financial Assistance through the State of Vermont and pay the copay determined by the state. Below are the rates per age group and information on Child Care Financial Assistance, Act 166, and the Child and Adult Care Food Program. Enrolled preschool families who don't apply for Act 166 will pay the full preschool rate.
